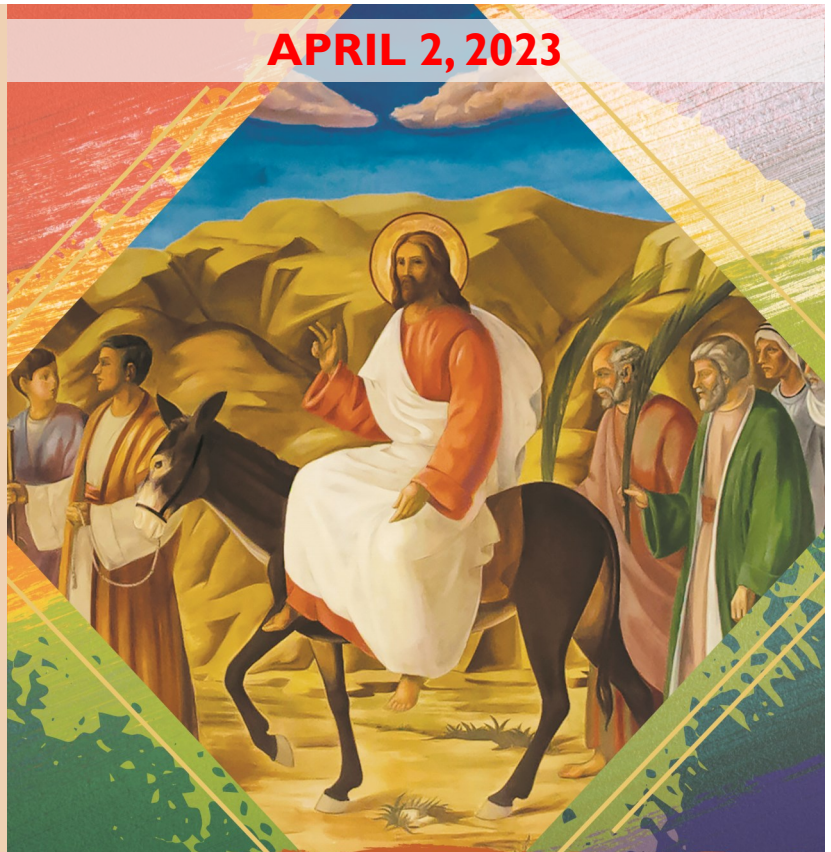

## *From the Pastor...*

Dear St. Mark Parishioners,

We begin our Holy Week with the celebration of Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord, when we recall our Lord's triumphant entrance into Jerusalem to offer His life for our sake. We will remember this entrance by beginning Mass in the cafeteria where we will bless the palms and then process into church. All are welcome to join in this procession.

This Wednesday will be the last day for 5:30pm Mass and the last additional confession time of 6-7pm. On Thursday, Friday, and Saturday there will be no 8am Mass. However, Mrs. Masidonski and others will be leading Morning Prayer at 8am on those days. All are welcome. You may join Archbishop Rozanski and the priests of the Archdiocese for Chrism Mass at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Louis at 10am on Holy Thursday. At 7pm on Holy Thursday, we will celebrate Mass of the Lord's Supper, remembering when the Lord gave the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass to His apostles and told them to "Do this in memory of me." At the end of Mass, we will process with the Blessed Sacrament to the Altar of Repose, remembering our Lord being arrested and taken away. Church will be open until midnight for you to spend time with Him.

On Good Friday, we will celebrate the Passion of the Lord at 7pm with Liturgy of the Word, veneration of the Cross, and Communion. On Holy Saturday, we will begin our Easter celebration with the Vigil starting at 8pm with the lighting of fire and the Paschal Candle. We will also welcome Richard Defer into full communion of the Church with his profession of faith, Confirmation, and 1<sup>st</sup> Holy Communion. On Sunday, we will have the joyous celebration of Easter with our usual Mass times of 7am, 9am, and 11am. I look forward to celebrating the joy of Easter with you, my parish family, once again!

There will be a collection for Retired Priests at all Easter Masses. Please see the baskets at the exits of church and give something to support retired priests who have done so much to serve the Church in St. Louis. Thank you!

We are very grateful to Lance Polette and his family for taking care of the lawn for so many years. Due to his many other obligations, Lance will be resigning from this position, so we will need someone to mow the parish lawns, trim the edges, and remove sticks and other debris from the property. Let me know if you or someone you know would be interested in this job.

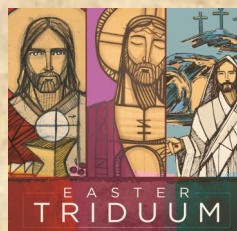

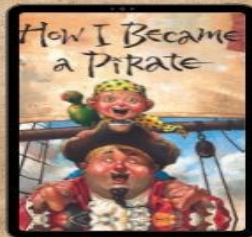

The souls that will go to confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment." Pope John Paul II granted a plenary indulgence to those who pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet and participate in Divine Mercy Sunday by going to confession, receiving Holy Communion and praying for the intentions of the Holy Father.
