


with the envelope that was sent to you in April, or you can to do <u>aca.archstl.org</u>. Thank you for helping those in need across the Archdiocese.

Parishioner donations to St. Vincent de Paul in April, May and June 2023 were \$11,551. Thank you so very much for your generosity.




FORWARD IN HOPE
