

successful in sharing our Catholic faith.



OUR NEW PASTOR FATHER BOB BURKEMPER

I was raised here in Lemay, beginning my education under the good Notre Dame Sisters at St. Martin of Tours Elementary School, continued with the Vincentian Fathers my studies at the old St. Louis Preparatory Seminary High School South, Cardinal Glennon College Seminary, and finally Kenrick Seminary.

After ordination as a diocesan priest in 1981, I have covered a lot of territory, starting as an associate pastor in:

I have one biological son, two stepsons and a dozen foster daughters.


With a Masters Degree in Theology I taught at St. Louis University High School for thirty years, from 1990 to 2020.

- Dubourg High School




