

PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

Next weekend the Season of Advent begins the Church's new Liturgical Year, a brief span of only twenty-one days this year, in which we are meant to prepare ourselves for the great Festival of the Lord's Birth at Christmas, through acts of **prayer**, **penance**, **and charity**.

I encourage you to actively plan to refocus your personal prayer and to renew your own participation in the usual opportunities for communal prayer here: in the Holy Mass each Sunday, and also in the three daily Masses, (6:30 AM, 8:00 AM & Noon), in Eucharistic Adoration on Thursdays, and in the various special Devotions to Jesus and His Blessed Mother throughout the season.

The priests of the parish will also offer an expanded schedule for the Sacrament of Reconciliation, with Confessions available on each of the three Thursdays of Advent at St. Mark's from 6:00 PM until all are heard, and at St. Martin's on Wednesday, December 20 from 7:00 PM until all are heard (That night all three priests will be available).

As noted further on in this bulletin there are also communal opportunities for charity with our **Giving Trees**, and the "**Pop Up Cookie Sale**", both supporting the work of the St. Vincent DePaul Society in our area.

The Lord Jesus is anxious to come into our lives offering us His Light and Peace, but He will not force Himself upon us.

Christ chose to come first in Bethlehem—choses to come to those who daily invite him in—and has promised to come again in Glory if we take his first two comings seriously.

FEAST OF ST. ANDREW



This Thursday, November 30 the 8:00 AM Mass will be celebrated at St. Andrew's Martin not at St. Mark's Church.

Andrew, a Galilean fisherman, was the first called of Jesus' Twelve Apostles.

He is remembered in the Gospels as the one who had a talent for bringing others to the Lord, starting with his brother Simon Peter.

Andrew is always prominent the lists of the Twelve and the few glimpses we get of him suggest he was a person Jesus could always depend upon.

Legendary accounts say Andrew brought the Good News of Christ's Gospel to various regions, in the area of the Aegean and Black Seas before giving up his life as a martyr around the year 60 AD near the Greek city of Patras.

Andrew, like his brother Simon Peter was condemned to be crucified, and is supposed to have protested that he also was not worthy to die in the same way as Jesus, His Lord—so he was bound, not nailed to a cross shaped like the letter X.

Besides being the heavenly patron of Lemay's senior parish, he is also patron of singers, fisherman, as well as the nations of Scotland, Russia, and Romania.


