




Commentary

ORDINARY INCOME: collections & investment income from each of the former parish communities. **EXTRAORDINARY INCOME:** St. Mark Bingo & St Martin Bingo.

ORDINARY EXPENSE: Is reported proportionately based on the number of registered households in June 2023 from each of the former communities unless there are unique expenses at a single site. (St. Andrew 7.2% / St. Bernadette 9.9% / St. Matthias 27.1% / St. Mark 39% / St. Martin 16.8%)

EXTRAORDINARY EXPENSE: For St. Mark consists of July salaries for former hourly employees of the school & painting of the rectory interior.

DEFICITS: Are paid out of the former community savings (held in the St. Louis Archdiocesan Fund as CDs & Money Market Accounts).

SURPLUS: Is placed in the checking accounts of the former parish community.
