


# THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

I am pleased to report that on Thursday, December 14th representatives from each of our constituent communities gathered for the **Second Pastoral Council Meeting**.

The lay leadership present included: a new member Mike Starnes (*St Andrew*), Stephanie Parker (*St. Martin*), Frank Speck (*St. Martin's Finance Council*), Sharon Sparwasser (*St. Mark's Finance Council*), and Jan Sorth (*St. Bernadette*) who participated via speaker phone.

Neither Steve Compas (*St. Mark*), nor Pat Meyer (St. Matthias) were able to attend.

Our three priests and Deacons Kurt Loeffler, Jesse Gatmaitan, and Ron Holmes also participated.

Jessi Livingood, our pastoral assistant took notes for the Council Meeting.

The Meeting began with a guided reflection on the often misunderstood Advent virtue of Docility — which is not passivity in the face of change but the prerequisite disposition that all of us stand in need of to be teachable.

The root of the word Docile comes from the Latin "docere", which means "to teach", and if we believe there is nothing to be learned from each other meaningful dialogue is impossible.

As in our previous meeting we each shared our personal experience of transition since our last meeting in October.

Many saw signs that seem to indicate we are working to welcome new faces in each of our current sites.

Some noted the increased participation of members from all sites taking part in various events hosted by several organizations — especially the Ladies Guild, the Men's Club and the Legion of Mary.

This is not to say that all the negative aspects of change have been dealt with.

Residual confusion, anxiety, sadness, and suspicion are still evident and can only be healed by continued patience and prayer.

Rumors continue be the bane of our common life — most recently those concerning the promised permanent Mass Schedule.

I then shared the actual proposal for the more permanent Mass schedule with the Council as it was published in last weekend's Bulletin.

After our priests discussed the attendance, quality of celebration, and participation in the Liturgy at each site, we proposed moving to two Saturday and four Sunday Masses to be celebrated at two sites — St. Mark and St. Martin.

The Saturday Vigil Masses will be celebrated at 4:00 PM in St. Martin Church and at 5:00 in St. Mark Church — and the Sunday Morning Masses at 7:00, 9:00 & 11:00 AM in St. Mark and then 10:00 in St. Martin.

Input from the Council indicated that this proposal came as no real surprise, and it was a good idea to wait until the first Sunday of Lent for its implementation.

Other matters discussed included: several needed repairs to the Rectory, installation of a handicapped entrance to the School's adult wing; the options for a Fish Fry for Lent and an appeal to Rome by a St. Bernadette member.

The Pastoral Council Meeting ended with a prayer and seemed to be well received by all the participants

Our next Meeting will be held in February.
