

### REPORT ON THE FISH FRY MEETING

Over twenty participants attended a meeting on January 8 to discuss a Lenten Fish Fry.

Following that meeting, having listened to the pros and cons on the two possible sites, St. Matthias & St. Mark, the priests discussed which seemed preferable so a decision could be made.

Both sites have ample dining space & equipment.

St. Matthias has excellent parking, though the site on Buckley Road provides less visibility to the public.

St. Mark has less parking, a larger kitchen, and more visibility to the public on Union Road.

The deciding factor came down to volunteers, as it was reported that there was serious doubt that many of the former workers at St. Matthias would return even if that site were chosen for the Fish Frys.

After a day's reflection the priests proposed:

- The Fish Frys take place at the St. Mark site on each of the seven Fridays of Lent but <u>not</u> on Ash Wednesday.
- This would require two teams of volunteers to decrease worker burn-out one team for February 16, March 1, & March 15, while another team would cover February 23, March 8, March 22 while a combined team would cover Good Friday, March 29.

On January 10, the first meeting's participants were then invited to a strategy meeting at St. Mark's Office Building on Saturday, January 13 to address feasibility, leadership and division of tasks.

More detailed information will be provided in next week's Bulletin.

Please consider volunteering to share in this substantial communal Lenten endeavor.




