

THE PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

As Lent approaches and our new Sacramental Schedule is about to be implemented, it is time to reconfigure our liturgical ministries in order to incorporate all members of our Catholic Faith Community who wish to serve in various ways.

We have need of Sacristans, Greeters (Ushers), Acolytes (Altar Servers), Lectors (Readers), and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion—young or older, male or female—to share your talents in both of our worship sites, at St. Mark and St. Martin.

If you wish to continue a current ministry or seek to begin a new one, I ask that you make your desires known by completing the following form and returning it in the collection basket.

As the celebrants wish to establish a common practice for all these ministers at both churches, we will lead a brief instruction for a particular ministry after Sunday Masses during Lent.

The times and dates for these instruction will be published in future bulletins.

Just before Easter a new list of assignments will be distributed for each ministry.

As for **Music Ministers** (*Choir Members, Cantors, & Instrumentalists*) if you have a particular talent you would like to share please offer your services to the Music Director of the Mass you usually attend.

For Masses celebrated at St. Martin: **Susan Mayfield** directs the Saturday 4 PM Mass and **Mary Pancella** directs the Sunday 10 AM Mass.

For Masses celebrated at St. Mark: *Rose Masidonski* coordinates all Mass music.



Father Rick was a joy to live with, a voice of reason and encouragement in times of stress, and a constant credit to Christ our Eternal High Priest.

He will be sorely missed by all who knew and loved him.
