



PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

Things in our parishes have begun to wind down as we head into 2025's summer haze, and so I need to report several items: the results of the St. Mark's Lenten Fish Frys, St. Martin's Men's Club Bar-B-Que and the date for setting our two 2025-2026 Parish Calendars and the Memorial Day Mass Site.

First let me once more thank everyone who worked so hard on both the Fish Frys and Bar-B-Que — the product of your labors was, as always, delicious.

I also express gratitude to all who patronized the culinary excellence of these two efforts.

For the seven Fridays of Lent the **Fish Frys** we averaged **558 meals** served per week, which netted St. Mark an overall **profit of \$ 29,704**.

At the Spring **Bar-B-Que**, held on April 26th & 27th, it is reported that **519 meals** were served and St. Martin saw **\$ 2,400** in profit.

These events are a great sign of the vitality of our two parishes, and the fine cooperation which is developing between them.

Focusing on the future, it is time for us to set the official **Parish Calendars** for our St. Martin and St. Mark communities.

I ask a single representative from each of our groups, ministries and clubs to come with their plans for the upcoming year (i.e. July 2025 through June 2026) to a meeting on Wednesday, June 11th at 7:00 PM in the Meeting Room of the Pastoral Office Building (4200 Ripa Avenue).

What will be needed from the representatives is a list of the dates and sites for any activities, meetings, or gatherings requiring the use of parish facilities at either parish site.

Also, by way of reminder, all are invited to celebrate Memorial Day, May 26th at a single Mass at 9:00 AM in St. Mark Church.





Applications for the 2025-26 Scholarship Grant Program sponsored by St. Martin's Bingo are being accepted now for students attending any Catholic School or Parish School of Religion (PSR) Program.

This program offers **tuition grants** of \$1,600 for any student attending a Catholic Pre-school (age 4 or 5), Grade School, or High School and \$200 for any student attending any PSR program.

Any Parents or grandparents, who are registered parishioners of St. Martin of Tours or St. Mark, who actively practice the Catholic Faith are eligible to apply.

Applicants will be **required** to volunteer for a certain number of shifts at St. Martin or St. Mark fundraisers depending on the size of the grant.


