#### PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

ETIQUETTE — a customary code of behavior in society among members of a particular group.

Today's solemn feast of *Corpus Christi* calls us to address our social customs for *Holy Mass*.

#### **Eucharistic Etiquette for Catholics presumes:**

- **I. Preparation** should always be customary—
- **Examine your conscience** to recognize any serious sin requiring sacramental confession before receiving Holy Communion.
- **The Dress appropriately**, so as not to cause any distraction to the worshipping community.
- Arrive a few minutes prior to Mass to decide your personal intention for this particular celebration of faith.
- **Fast for one hour** prior to Holy Communion.
- II. Participation ought to be presumed—
- Audibly join in the sung & spoken responses recalling in these words you are speaking directly to Almighty God.
- **Wake a personal offering of yourself** with the bread and wine at the Preparation of the Gifts.
- ♣ At Holy Communion bow as the person before you receives, audibly proclaim your "Amen" before you extend your hands or tongue to receive Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament.

#### III. Thanksgiving must never be omitted—

- **Do not bolt for the doors** on your way back from Holy Communion, as a proper act of thanks needs to be made for the Wondrous Gift of Jesus Himself who has entered your heart.
- **♥** Express heartfelt gratitude for the Miracle in which you have just partaken, asking Jesus to send His Holy Spirit to help you live as a better witness to His Real Presence within you.

*Corpus Christi* invites us to better understand and appreciate proper reverence for the Sacred Body & Precious Blood of Christ required of each of us, *regular* preparation, participation & thanksgiving.



#### DO YOU KNOW WHY

We Make A Triple Sign Of The Cross Before The Gospel?

In standing to hear the Gospel, we acknowledge Jesus is uniquely present, and His teaching and example are applied to us.

We then make a sign of the cross on our forehead, lips and heart with a silent prayer: "May the words of the Holy Gospel be on my mind, on my lips and in my heart."

All the gestures and postures we employ before the Gospel, if we understand them help us to listen to and act on Christ's Word.

The use of incense, the sung Alleluia, and our dialogue with the deacon or priest, prior to the reading also help us to focus our attention on Christ speaking directly to us.

May the triple sign of the cross become for us an expression of our desire and good intention to hear and live the Gospel.

#### The Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus—Friday, June 27


This feast honoring Our Lord's Sacred Heart was requested by Jesus in a vision given to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in 1675.

He wanted it celebrated on the Friday following Corpus Christi and the feast was made part of the Church's calendar in 1856.

St. John Paul II, a great devotee of the Sacred Heart, said, "This reminds us of the mystery of the love of God for people of all times."

#### The Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary—Saturday, June 28

Pope Pius XII instituted this feast for the Universal Church honoring Our Lady's Immaculate Heart to be celebrated on the octave day of the Solemnity of Mary's Assumption into Heaven in 1944.



Following the Second Vatican Council, St. Pope Paul VI moved the feast to the Saturday following Corpus Christi to link it to the celebration of Jesus' Most Sacred Heart.

In honoring the Heart of the Blessed Virgin, we can ponder in our hearts what she pondered throughout her lifetime, the love she had for Jesus, her Divine Son.


