## PASTOR'S PERSPECTIVE

'It seems to be the season for *vacancies* — Fr. Allen and I have commented that at both our parishes the pews are more sparsely filled in the summertime.

I recall an old saw about mutual goodness to be shown both geese and ganders so this weekend, as one of the Vincentian Fathers presents the Missionary Cooperation Plan at St. Mark's, Fr. Allen has taken the weekend offa sort of mini-vacation.

Next weekend, with the Vincentians again sending a priest for the same cause, this time to St. Martin, it's my turn to *vacate* the premises.

So you are aware: regulations for permissible absences of priests of the Archdiocese allow each priest a total of 6 weeks of vacancy annually: a week for spiritual retreat, a week Wednesday, July 9 for some form of academic study, and another four weeks for personal vacation and renewal.

Usually Father Allen and I space our absences so that one of us is always present, but in this instance there are two days when we can't.

Next Friday I'm traveling to St. Meinrad Abbey in Indiana for a few days of retreat with the monk who is my personal spiritual director, followed by a few days of R&R with friends.

While I am away Fr. Allen has also scheduled three days of retreat and will be unable to celebrate Holy Mass at either parish on Tuesday, July 15th or Wednesday July 16th.

We are most grateful that Deacon Jesse Gatmaitan has generously agreed to lead a Communion Service at 8:00 AM in St. Mark's on each of those days.

It is my sincere hope for the priests and people of our parishes that all may benefit from some summer *vacancy* for personal renewal!



## DID YOU KNOW WHY... The New Pope Chooses a New Name?

In the first centuries of the Church's history the bishops of Rome used their given baptismal names upon their election to the Papacy.

It was only in the Sixth Century (533) Pope John II, out of embarrassment, exchanged his baptismal name "Mercurius" (*Mercury—pagan god*) for the name of the Lord's Beloved Disciple.

About the 11th century the popes began to regularly choose the names of their predecessors in the Papal Office to show "continuity" with the past.

Starting in the mid-20th Century new popes began to choose names which hinted at the direction their papacy would most likely follow.

By choosing to be called **Leo XIV**, Cardinal Robert Prevost seemed to suggest he may make social justice one of his priorities, as did Pope Leo XIII before him.

The earlier Leo, (pope from 1878-1903) wrote "Rerum Novarum" (On New Things) a groundbreaking encyclical letter which addressed the rights of modern workers and their working conditions.


