

COMMENTARY

+ **Note:** The recent *Parish Census* offers a more realistic understanding of the number of Catholics who are actively engaged in St. Mark's Parish.

St. Mark's registered parishioners number **2415**, individuals & fall into six age groups,

Those Under 20 = 151 51—70 = 709
21—30 = 189 71—90 = 725
31—50 = 527 Over 90 = 114

The parishioners average age is **58 years**.

++ Note: The *Ordinary Surplus* of \$ 352,192 basically is a result of Grant Revenues.

+++ Note: *Capital Expenditures* to the each of the four sites of St. Mark Parish include:

For St. Mark's Site (\$ 470,155) — for a new School HVAC , a new Roof on the oldest wing of the School , a new Sidewalk that leads from the Church to the Pastoral Office & a Snowplow Attachment (*this last expense was shared with St. Martin*).

For St. Andrew's Site (\$ 32,015) — for a : School AC Compressor & repairs to the School Boiler

For St. Matthias' Site (\$ 33,859) — for several window AC Units (*this expense was shared with Providence Academy*), new Glass Doors for the School, repairs to School Boiler, repairs to the leaks in the School's Foundation & Gym Roof, as well as a downpayment for Excavation of a spring which sprouted in the parking lot.

++++ Note: *2024-2025 Net Deficit* results from the various repairs and improvements to St. Mark's multiple sites, but given the size of so many deferred maintenance projects at each plant, the use of only **\$ 143,766** is remarkable.

The Office of Shared Accounting projects St. Mark to end Fiscal Year 2026 with a positive Net Surplus.

Overall St. Mark Parish is addressing all our unique challenges as well as can be expected.

We can all be grateful to the members of our new Finance Council for their generous assistance in advising on so many financial issues.

COMMENTARY

+ **Note:** The recent *Parish Census* offers a more realistic understanding of the number of Catholics who are actively engaged in St. Martin of Tours Parish.

St. Martin's registered parishioners number **617** individuals and fall into six age groups:
Those Under 20 = 37 51—70 = 206
21—30 = 28 71—90 = 271
31—50 = 60 Over 90 = 15

The parishioners average age is *64 years*.

++ **Note:** The steep increase in *Personnel Costs* results from the shift in parochial status — St. Martin formerly paid just over 25%, and now covers 50% of the shared staff salaries & benefits.

+++ **Note:** *Ordinary Surplus* shows \$ 198,874 —this is the remainder of the Bingo's support of \$ 493,488.

Without Bingo St. Martin would have found itself with a deficit of **\$ 294,614**.

++++ **Note:** *Capital Expenditures* for the parish include: boiler & plaster damage in the School, repairs to the parking lot & a Snowplow Attachment (*this last expense was shared with St. Mark*).

+++++ **Note:** *2024-2025 Net Income* indicates what is left after Miscellaneous Income is added and Extraordinary Expenses for Capital Improvements are subtracted.

Our gratitude to the coordinators and volunteers who make St. Martin of Tours Bingo such a resounding success should be universal.

Yet, expensive deferred maintenance on the Church, Rectory and School must be addressed by more than these few heroic parishioners.

Roofing, guttering, interior plaster and painting all desperately need replacement or repair to avoid further structural damage.

In this week's **bulletin insert**, a *Letter to all St. Martin of Tours Parishioners*, you will see the proposed solution to this crisis — please read it carefully.

We will begin to address this beginning in October.


