A note from Mrs. Bingham

Dear Parents,

We have almost finished our second week of school and I am very proud of the students. They are getting into good routines and working hard to meet and exceed our expectations.

As we get into our school routines, it is good to review our four pillar virtues of Respect, Responsibility, Integrity, and Perseverance and how they can help us meet our academic goals.

<u>Respect</u>: We have to help students show respect for time. There is time in our day for everything. Talk to your child about schedules and set an afternoon schedule that makes time for homework and free time.

Responsibility: The virtue of responsibility can help our students improve organizational skills. We have to be responsible for writing our homework down and for remembering what books we need to bring home. We also have to remember to turn our homework in and to get notes signed.

Integrity: If we are struggling we may fall into the bad habit of taking short cuts in our work or not giving the time necessary to do our work well? Integrity calls us to be honest and adhere to strong moral and ethical values.

<u>Perseverance</u>: The virtue of perseverance can help us complete all of our school work on time and to the best of our ability. It calls us to finish our tasks well. It also makes us feel proud of our accomplishments. When we fail it is important for us to begin again and challenge ourselves to chase our goals.

As we begin this school year, call upon your faith and trust in God. Pray as a family and encourage your children to turn to God when they are stressed, worried, anxious, or angry.

Back to School Service Project




