## A note from Mrs. Bingham

Dear Parents,
We have almost finished our second week of school and I am very proud of the students. They are getting into good routines and working hard to meet and exceed our expectations.

As we get into our school routines, it is good to review our four pillar virtues of Respect, Responsibility, Integrity, and Perseverance and how they can help us meet our academic goals.

Respect: We have to help students show respect for time. There is time in our day for everything. Talk to your child about schedules and set an afternoon schedule that makes time for homework and free time.

It also makes us feel proud of our accomplishments. When we fail it is important for us to begin again and challenge ourselves to chase our goals.
