## Reflection from Fr. Jake

October 28, 2022

Dear Friends of St. Lawrence Newman Center,



What are you passionate about?

Whatever we are passionate about tells us a little bit about who we are. This is why when we are getting to know others, we often ask them such questions as: “what gets you excited?”, “what do you like to do in your spare time?”, and “what gets you out of bed in the morning?” Sometimes our passions even communicate our sense of purpose.

Have you ever wondered about the person of Jesus Christ in a real way? What is God attracted toward? What piques His interest? What is our Lord passionate about?

I would like to hold out a non-exhaustive list of themes from sacred Scripture that I have personally found very fruitful for my life of prayer. I have found that when I am “looking where He is looking” His interests start to become more my interests as well. Furthermore, what attracts Jesus helps us understand who He is, and helps us grasp that His passions are indeed His purpose.

Jesus is attracted by seeing **real faith**: “*not in all of Israel have I seen such faith*” Mt. 8:10

Jesus is attracted to **repentance**: “*there is more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents...*” Lk. 15:7

Jesus is attracted to the **small and the humble**: “*unless you become like children, you will not enter the kingdom of God*” Mt. 18:3

Jesus in His Mercy is drawn to **human misery**: “*Simon, do you see this woman?*” Lk. 7:44

Jesus is most especially drawn to the **hidden gesture of love**: “*this poor widow gave more than all the rest*” Lk. 21:3

Jesus is drawn to **audacity** in people expressing their needs: *“but he continued to cry out all the more, “Son of David, have mercy on me!”* Lk. 18:38

Jesus is drawn to Jerusalem and **the cross to give Himself**: *“he set his face like flint towards Jerusalem...”* Lk. 19:51

Jesus is attracted by **those who seek Him**: *“Zacchaeus...was seeking to see who Jesus was”* Lk. 19:3
