FLOCKNOTE TEXT & E-MAILS



Keeping you informed in a safe, easy & least obstructive way.

Flocknote texts & e-mails is our system to accomplish this goal. Your personal information remains protected. To sign up, follow the instructions provided.

Flocknote Texts. We keep you informed in 144 characters or less. These texts are quick reminders of important info.

Flocknote E-mails. For more in-depth details on Youth Ministry events, we will send an e-mail that will include links, fliers, and pertinent information.

NOTE: Flocknote tracks who opens or does not open e-mails. Please, read the e-mails.

CONTACT WITH MINORS FORM

In accordance with Safe Environment rules, we **DO NOT** contact minors directly either by text or by e-mail.

Flocknote is a Safe Environment method to communicate with your teens via text or e-mail. It keeps records of any text or e-mail response for review.

Teens receive Youth Ministry information safely and parents keep control. We ask you consider allowing us to have their cellphone & e-mail for that purpose.

NCYC & FUTURE EVENTS



Eight OLV Youth Ministry teens are Diocesan Ambassadors to the National Catholic Youth Conferene (NCYC) in November. We are very blessed with generous parishioners support for our goal of \$10K to cover teen and adult costs.

CORE ADULT VOLUNTEERS

Consider joining our CORE Adult Team:

- Must be 21 years (>25 to drive teens)
- Complete Safe Enviornment training
- · Complete Background Check
- · Leads small group talks with teens
- · Teaching not required, but encouraged
- Help with general ministry activities

ADULT EVENT TRANSPORTATION

We rely on parents and adults authorized for driving teens to attend off-campus events. In addition to Safe Environment and Background Check, you must:

- · Authorize a Motor vehicle Report
- Insurance liability \$100K/\$300K

PRAYER, SERVICE & SACRAMENTS

Our goal is to lead your teens and your family closer to Jesus Christ. To do this, we need you to be witness of Faith:

- Go to Mass every weekend
- Encourage teens to be Altar Servers, Lectors, and Hospitality Ministers
- Eucharistic Adoration, go regularly on Wednesdays; join us when we go pray
- Sacrament of Reconciliation, make it a family event; Monday 6-7:30pm, or on Wednesday 6:30-8pm. Be free of sin.
- Knight's 1st Wednesday Rosary, we would love to see more families join us
