Obtain the Jubilee Indulgence

Special graces for the forgiveness of sins are made available during the Jubilee Year. The faithful may obtain a plenary indulgence—remission of all temporal punishment (time in purgatory) for sin—by meeting the normal conditions:

- Confession
- Holy Communion
- Prayer for the Pope's intentions
- No attachment to sin,

And by participating in one of the following activities:

- Pilgrimages that include Mass
- Pious visits to sacred places—at these locations the faithful are to engage in Eucharistic adoration and meditation, and/or other spiritual practices.
- Works of mercy and penance -The faithful are to perform the spiritual or corporal works of mercy, or carry out works of penance, such as abstaining from meat on Fridays.
- Praying the Jubilee Prayer
