This has been a busy week in the garden, befitting the time of year.



Sunday, Kirston Burgher got the last pea-picking-party put together. His lovely family, the Dieringers, and Dennis McNulty participated and picked, not a "peck of peppers", but 52 pounds of delicious snap peas. Soon, the peas and Kirston's great pea-stringing structures will be gone

There are 12 cucumber and 40 tomato plants in the greenhouse that will be taking their place.

Sunday, Amanda Cornell and I transplanted 30 lettuces, 50 green beans, and 30 corn plants into the garden, and she watered the entire garden.

Monday, I harvested the 10 huge heads of Grandma Hadley's lettuce, and took the peas picked Sunday, to the main St. Vincent de Paul Food Bank. They were, as always, very happy to get fresh vegetables, since they get a lot of canned and otherwise, processed food donated.

I'll be putting the greenhouse tomatoes and cucumbers into the garden, where the peas have been so far. We're going to have a lot of those, if the summer holds out long enough.

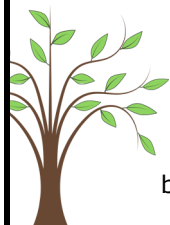

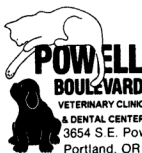
