Included in that food was lots of fresh produce from Baruch and the Marsh family. We were also given fresh grapes from a couple living near the pantry. I recently talked with a homeless couple at the pantry and each time I do this I am reminded of how very important rent and utility assistance is. Once you are on the street it is so difficult to get into a good shelter. This month we helped 7 adults and 10 children with rent and 8 adults and 9 children with utility assistance. ## A Friend in Need

We have been asked to help Sergio, a 53 year-old man who lives on a ranch in Guadalupe Valley in Baja California, Mexico. He has terminal cancer in his nasal passages and can no longer see.
