

We pause again to reflect on one who has given so much of his talent to our parish and other charitable organizations. He is a great role model to all of us about proclaiming God's love through the giving of his time, talent and treasure.

Although Doug Hunt, who passed away in September, could easily fit into all three categories, we are highlighting his dedication of talent (sharing his gifts) to the community.

Doug was Vincentian of the year in 2014. He was one of the founders of Holy Family's St. Vincent de Paul Conference and at age 90 he was still reporting to Emergency Services of the Portland Chapter every Monday for a 4 hour shift answering the food line. He would not take a day off even when his son was coming to town. Doug took all the rent and utility requests at our local Conference. He and Gene Szekely used to work at St. Vincent Cafe and were most generous to each person they served. As Veronica Kennedy, SVDP Conference Liason, said he was always kind and non-judgemental with the poor. The world could be crashing around him and he would focus on those needing food or other assistance as needed.

Doug's talents were demonstrated by "hands full of heart". Doug was compassionate beyond anything. He had a listening ear and was able to serve others, especially the poor and those in need, with a generous spirit that was felt by all. He did not "give up" on anyone, but rather he reached out to each of them and treatied each one with dignity.

Doug was a longtime parishioner who is greatly missed, and he was exemplary in sharing his talents as he served his God.




