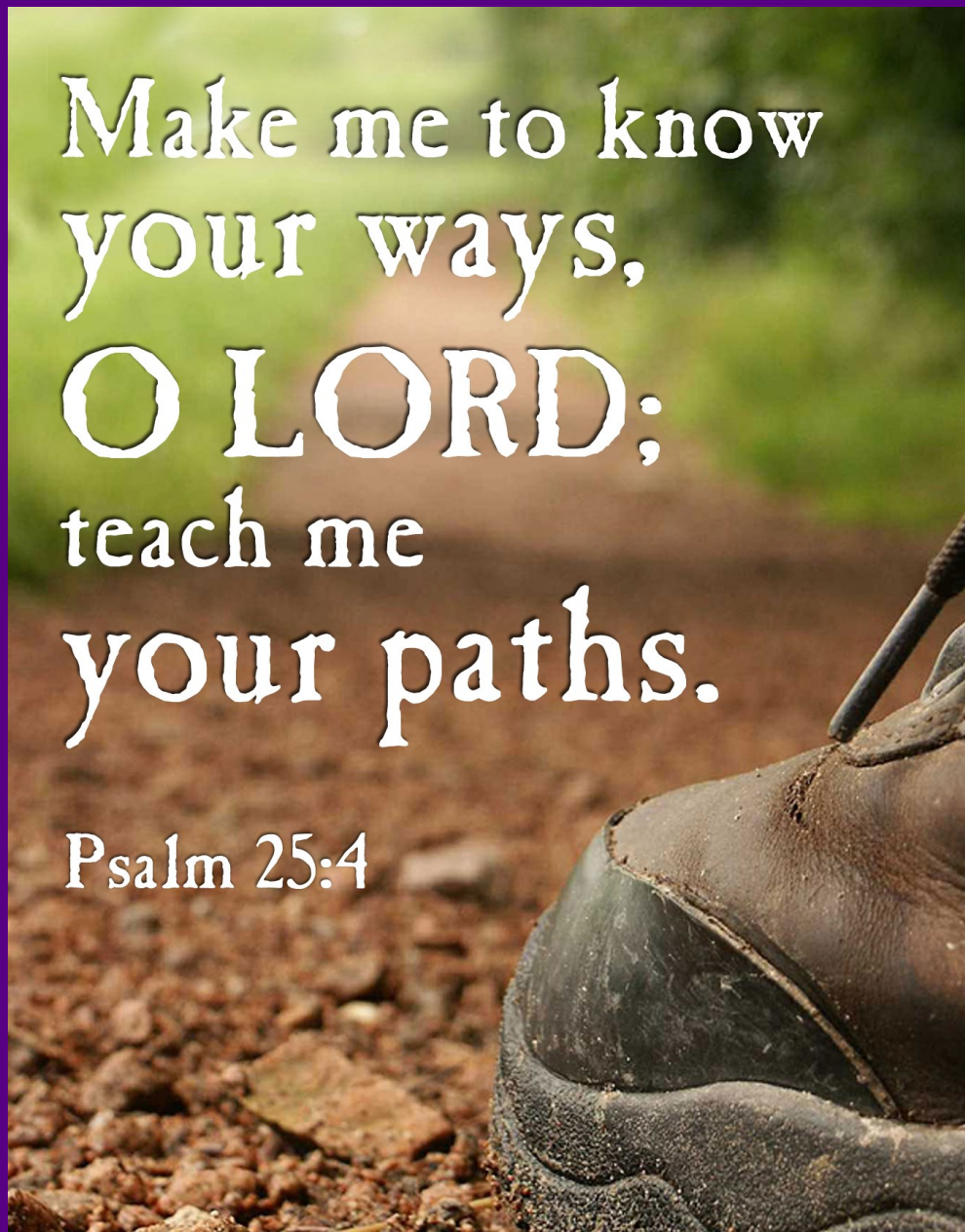

## All Ages Christmas Movie Night!

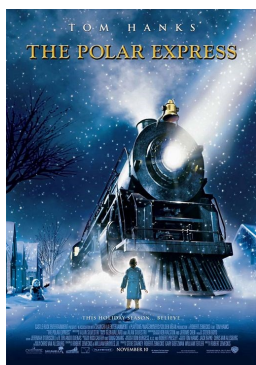
It's that time of year again! Drop off the kids and get some last minute shopping done or have a quiet dinner before the Holidays get even busier.

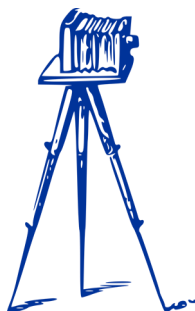

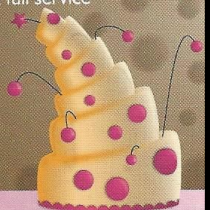
