



Jesus reverses everything that was considered socially and religiously 'correct'. The poor, crippled, lame, blind were excluded from the priesthood and some claimed they were not eligible to participate in the heavenly banquet. The Kingdom of God revealed by Jesus is there is a great reversal about to take place. Notice the extreme nature of Jesus' challenge. He doesn't say give money to the poor, give some volunteer service hours to the poor, but 'invite them into your home, to sit at table and eat together'! To enter into a relationship that goes beyond 'charity'.
