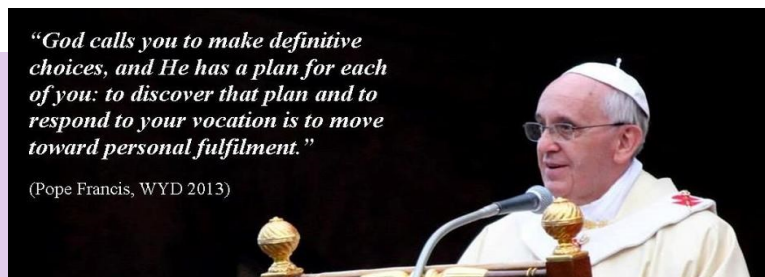

FEAST DAY OF ST. MARTIN OF TOURS— NOVEMBER 11— VETERAN'S DAY

St. Martin of Tours was a Roman soldier who was baptized as an adult and became a monk. It is understood that he was a kind man who led a quiet and simple life. The best known legend of his life is that he once cut his cloak in half to share with a beggar during a snowstorm, to save the beggar from dying in the cold. That night he dreamed that Jesus was wearing the half-cloak. Martin heard Jesus say to the angels, "Here is Martin, the Roman soldier who is not baptized; he has clothed me."

We celebrate the feast of St. Martin of Tours on November 11th, this day is known as Martinmas and celebrated in many different countries. Holy Family will celebrate once again this year by donating coats to the needy. Please join us by bringing clean, gently used coats and mittens/hats/scarves to church next weekend—November 11/12.
