

Ideas for activities for you and your family this week:

- Celebrate Palm Sunday by making crosses out of palms.
- Before coloring Easter eggs, let children write messages on eggs in crayon that celebrate the true meaning of Easter.
 i.e. "Christ is risen," "Jesus loves us."
- Emphasize the importance of service on Holy Thursday by helping someone in need—"washing someone's feet".
- Acknowledge the sadness of Good Friday by encouraging your children to write letters (you, too!) or draw pictures for people who are grieving the loss of a loved one.

- Take time to bake Braided Easter Bread or Hot Cross Buns as a family and deliver to neighbors or shut ins.
- Say extra prayers and make cards to help us welcome those joining our faith at the Easter Vigil or during the Easter Season.

Holy Thursday, March 29th

Commemorates the Last Supper when Jesus gave us the gift of himself in the Eucharist and set an example of service by washing the apostles feet. Mass at 7 PM followed by

Adoration in Celebration Hall for those who can come and pray until 11:30 PM

Good Friday, March 30th

Recalls the crucifixion and death of Jesus. This is a fasting day for all Catholics and abstinence (no meat). The church is bare on Good Friday, the altar stripped of ornamentation and the tabernacle left open and empty. Mass is not celebrated this day. Please join us at 2 PM for the "Seven Last Words". Return at 7 PM for the Passion of the Lord, Veneration of the Cross and Communion.

Holy Saturday, March 31st

A day of waiting as we prepare our hearts and homes for the resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. The Vigil Mass draws us into Jesus' victory over sin and death that is now ours.

Vigil Service & Mass begins at 8:00 PM outside the church around the fire. This is the time our RCIA Candidates receive the sacraments of initiation.



Last week we began our commitment to make 120 lunches once a month for the women and residents at Willamette Shelter, located in the former SVDP headquarters on Milwaukie Ave. and opened in 2017.

It is a 120-bed emergency shelter open 24/7 for women and couples in SE Portland.

At this time we are scheduled to provide these lunches through October, with the school preparing and delivering during the school months. We have procured donations of bread and fruit and the classes preparing for a specific month will provide peanut butter & jam, as well as granola bars, a snack and small beverage.

Our own Penny O'Connell will spend time in the classroom discussing homelessness and other members of the parish will provide assistance as needed.

What an incredible project for us to be working on together as we help instill a spirit of service in our young parishioners who are our students. Last week, the 8th grade and 4th grade classes prepared the sack lunches and parents and older students delivered them.
