

The Mission of Holy Family Catholic Parish is to be a welcoming faith community grounded in Gospel values and dedicated to making God known to our members and all who enter our doors. We foster positive relationships with God and one another through a life of stewardship and active participation in the ministries of worship, education, service, and community.



The celebration of the Paschal Mystery of our Lord this Holy Week is just around the corner. I once again encourage you to participate in our Paschal/Easter *Triduum*. We call these days the Paschal *Triduum* or the Easter *Triduum* because they are the three days wherein we remember the suffering, death and resurrection of our Lord. The title, Paschal, focuses on Jesus' Passover from death to life while Easter focuses on the most important commemoration of God's saving work for us, his resurrection.

The Paschal/Easter *Triduum* is the summit of the Liturgical Year and the most important celebration in the Catholic Church. It starts from the evening of Holy Thursday to the evening of Easter Sunday. Though chronologically three days, they are liturgically one day unfolding for us the unity of Christ's Paschal Mystery. The single celebration of the *Triduum* marks the end of the Lenten season, and leads to the Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord at the Easter Vigil.

The liturgical services that take place during the *Triduum* are: Mass of the Lord's Supper (Holy Thursday), Good Friday of the Lord's Passion and Mass of the Resurrection of the Lord (Easter Vigil). I hope that you can be part of this important celebration of our faith.

Also, I would like to introduce to you an opportunity to reflect on the journey of Jesus on the cross through our personal life experiences. This Good Friday, we are going to reflect on the Seven Last Words of Jesus on the Cross. These are the words that Jesus spoke before He died. The first word is from Luke 23:34 – *'Father, Forgive them, for they know not what they do.'* A couple will share their experience as husband and wife about the value of forgiveness in their life and rela-

tionship. The second word is from Luke 23:43 - "Amen I say to you, today you will be with me in paradise." Someone will share about her reflection on death and her journey or experience of it with her late husband. The third word is from John 19:26-27 – 'When Jesus therefore had seen his mother and the disciple standing whom he loved, he said to his mother: Woman, behold thy son. After that, he said to the disciple: Behold thy mother." Someone, a mother and a daughter herself, will speak about the joys and challenges of being a mother (parent) and how it is to be a daughter herself and what is her reflection about them. The fourth word is from Matthew 27:46 - "And about the ninth hour Jesus cried with a loud voice, saying: Eli, Eli, lamma sabacthani? that is, My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?" A couple, who both experienced a great loss of a loved one in their life, will share their reflection about their experience and how are they finding strength to overcome it. The fifth word is from John 19:28 – "Afterwards, Jesus knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the scripture might be fulfilled, said: I thirst." A young person will share about what it is she is looking or searching for in her life and faith and how is she finding the answer for them in her life. The sixth word is from John 19:30 - "Jesus therefore, when he had taken the vinegar, said: It is finished." A couple will talk about the challenges they experienced or are experiencing in their married life and how have they overcome or are overcoming them. The seventh word is from Luke 23:46 - "And Jesus crying with a loud voice, said: Father, into thy hands I commend my spirit." Someone will share about his discernment on becoming a deacon and the process he does in making major decisions in his life.

These reflections on the last moments of Jesus' life through the experiences of some of our brothers and sisters in our community are going to be a very intimate and meaningful encounter. I hope that you can be part of this amazing journey we have with Jesus and with each other. We are all in this together.
