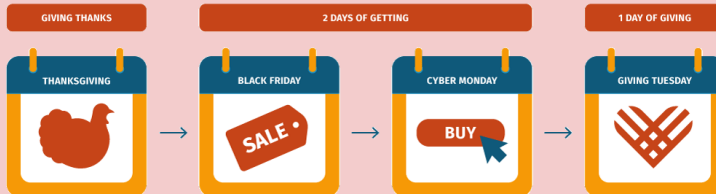

Their families live in Redmond and they will be coming there as soon as they find a place to live. I will take things over there in the next week or so. My brother has a truck and trailer and will take anything we can collect down to CA. They are looking for an apt. before they come up to Redmond, so whatever they can't use, someone else can. If you have something to donate please contact me and I'll pick it up. I'll need all donations by Monday, November 19th. Please call me or email and I will pick up whatever you can gather together - used, new, whatever.
