



### **Gospel Reflection**

The 33rd Sunday of Ordinary Time November 18th—Mark 13:24-32

As we near the end of the liturgical year, today's Gospel talks about the second coming of Jesus. Jesus, the teacher, used images from the sky (comets, meteors, eclipses) to strengthen his disciples' faith in God's care. Mark's Gospel reminds us that in any darkness Jesus will always come in glory.

♥ How do you think people might act if Jesus were to return tomorrow? Our Parishioner, Kathy McMahon, will be collecting household goods to help out the people displaced by the fires. Here is her request:

Obviously we need to ramp up the prayers for CA as you well know from hearing the news. I also have a request for what we can do for corporal needs. As I mentioned on the Prayer Circle, my nephew and his family live in Paradise. They have lost EVERYTHING - their whole life together, and so have their friends and neighbors. My niece is a teacher and her school is gone too. She and her daughter barely made it out. Praise God they are ok.

I would like to collect material things such as linens, kitchen utensils, and anything else my car can hold. Their families live in Redmond and they will be coming there as soon as they find a place to live. I will take things over there in the next week or so. My brother has a truck and trailer and will take anything we can collect down to CA. They are looking for an apt. before they come up to Redmond, so whatever they can't use, someone else can. If you have something to donate please contact me and I'll pick it up. I'll need all donations by Monday, November 19th.

Please call me or email and I will pick up whatever you can gather together - used, new, whatever.
