PASTOR'S CORNER

Did you know that the month of February is dedicated to Holy Family? The Catholic Church has put together a devotional theme for each of the month and February is dedicated to the devotion to Holy Family to remember their hidden life at Nazareth. This devotion encourages us to take Holy Family, our namesake as a parish, to be the model of virtue in all our households. This devotion started in

the 17th century almost simultaneously in Canada and France. The Copts have also observed this since early times on the account of the flight to Egypt by the Holy Family. It is said that this devotion is seen as an "efficacious means of bringing home to the Christian people the example of the Holy Family at Nazareth and… the restoration of the true spirit of family life."

There are a few things we can do to celebrate this: The first is to dedicate ourselves to the Holy Family every day. I have attached the prayer to the Consecration to the Holy Family that we can pray with our family: "O Jesus, our most loving Redeemer, who having come to enlighten the world with Thy teaching and example, didst will to pass the greater part of Thy life in humility and subjection to Mary and Joseph in the poor home in Nazareth, thus sanctifying the Family that was to be an example for all Christian families,



graciously receive our family as it dedicates and consecrates itself to Thee this day. Do Thou defend us, guard us and establish amongst us Thy holy fear, true peace, and concord in Christian love: in order that, by conforming ourselves to the divine pattern of Thy family, we may be able, all of us without exception, to attain to eternal happiness. Mary, dear Mother of Jesus and Mother of us, by thy kindly intercession make this

our humble offering acceptable in the sight of Jesus, and obtain for us His graces and blessings. O Saint Joseph, most holy guardian of Jesus and Mary, assist us by thy prayers in all our spiritual and temporal necessities; that so we may be enabled to praise our divine Savior Jesus, together with Mary and thee, for all eternity. Amen." As a parish, we are going to pray this in our every council meeting this month.

Second, I would like to encourage you to strengthen your family bonds by taking the time this month to appreciate one another. So, think of something that you can do for your loved ones that would make them feel appreciated and loved. Make sure that you express it to them personally. I hope that with these two things, we can honor the example of the Holy Family in our community.


