



GOSPEL REFLECTION

Rv 11:19a; 12:1-6a, 10ab/1 Cor 15:20-27/Lk 1:39-56

NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME Jn 6:41-51

In today's Gospel passage, Jesus teaches that his Father draws one to believe and that those who believe in Him (Jesus) have everlasting life. He reiterates the point that he is the bread of life from heaven, and that those who eat this bread (listen to and accept his word) will not die.

When you feel drawn to something good, it is God who is drawing you. The drawing may be felt as a tug on the heart, or as a good idea or perhaps it is a kind word that gives courage. This is how God works in our world.

Our prayer is not our own initiative, but is itself a response to God who draws us. God draws me to what is true, to what is life-giving, to what is loving.

There has been a large jump of cases and hospitalizations for COVID 19 cases here in Oregon because of the highly transmissible Delta Variant.
