GOSPEL REFLECTION

Lk 11:1-13

Prayer was an integral part of Jesus' life and mission. He is the teacher of prayer and gives us a model of prayer. His relationship with the Father was at the core of his life and ministry. His disciples often saw Jesus in prayer. They could have had no doubt that he was in deep communion with his father. He was praying in the certainty that the Father heard him. No wonder they asked him to teach them how to pray. And how surprised that he used such simple language! So he teaches them how to have a conversation with God. Jesus reminds us of the importance of intercession, of asking for what we need. Asking for something for ourselves does not come readily to many of us. It can be easier to ask for a favor for someone else. We know God is the giver of every good gift and will give us what is for our good. Lord, help me to ask confidently, expectantly and joyfully for my

needs and the needs of others at this time.
