Marge joined Holy Family parish some-time around 1955. She and her husband Francis were building their home on Henderson Street. In the years following, they would have six children—Gordy, Dan, Dave, Cindy, Kathy and Peggy. Henderson Street, from 45th to 39th, was a street that was growing with homes filled with families—many of which were members of Holy Family Parish and School.

Marge was an active mom in the lives of her children as they attended Holy Family School. She took her turn at volunteering for hot lunch; she served terms as Parent's Club president; assisted in the library or with other school duties; volunteered for the fundraisers, etc. Marge and Fran were members of Christian Family Movement and active in St. Vincent de Paul. Marge was a Girl Scout Leader and coached girl's CYO Basketball. The Watzig Home was often a gathering place for friends who were frequent recipients of Marge's famous peanut butter cookies.

Marge and Fran always attended the various social events at Holy Family and if there was music she was dancing! Marge was part of the Christian Service Committee and organized many a funeral reception over the years. She was also an active member of Altar Society—mostly taking care of the altar linens and father's vestments. And ... NOW ... at 100 ... she is still ironing the altar linens that we use at all of our masses. Thank You Marge for this ongoing ministry!



Marge has been widowed for 29 years, but she is as active as she can be. On a nice day you will see her working in her front yard. When asked how she made it to 100, she replied,

“Love family, love God, stay active!”

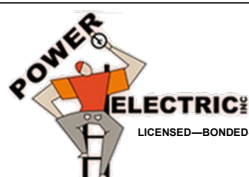
