

TWO DAY MISSION ON RECONCILIATION Tying into "The Light is On" 6PM to 8PM March 20 & 21

I know like - confession it isn't fun and I hate being in that little box with the priest staring me down. It has been forever since I went to confession and I don't know where to start. Why do I have to tell my sins to a priest?

Right -these are all questions that I hear all the time.

I have a solution - confession like you never had before. Come and join us and see what I am talking about...I make a covenant with you that it will be an experience like you never had before and **you will LOVE it!** Come find out what it is all about!

Quick Summary

DAY #1

- A) A short talk on reconciliation and why we do what we do.
- B) I will expose Jesus and we will go through an extensive examination of conscience. I am sure you will find some sins that you don't think are sins and also dig up deep sins from the past...so bring pad and pen so we can write our sins.

THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT! YOU MUST HAVE PENCIL/PEN AND PAPER!

C) I will repose Jesus and then the night will end.

DAY #2

- A. Short review for those who missed the first night.
- B. Short examination of conscience
- C. This is where it gets very different. We will have a burning service where we actually place the sins we wrote in a fire to send them up to God like incense in a thurible.
- D. After confession you are free to go home being cleansed disciples of God and to be prepared for Holy Week...Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Easter Vigil/Sunday. I pray I see y'all at each one of these and experience Easter like never before.
