FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 2, 2025

The Presentation of Jesus at (or in) the Temple is an early episode in the life of **Jesus**, describing his presentation at the **Temple in Jerusalem** in order to officially induct him into **Judaism**, that is celebrated by many Christian Churches on the holiday of **Candlemas**. It is described in **Chapter 2** of the Gospel of Luke in the New Testament of the Christian Bible.[1] Within the account, "Luke's narration of the Presentation in the Temple combines the purification rite with the Jewish ceremony of the redemption of the firstborn (Luke 2:23-24)."[2] In the Catholic Church, especially since the time of Pope Gelasius I (492-496) who in the fifth century contributed to its expansion, the Presentation is celebrated on February 2nd and is the fourth Joyful Mystery of the Rosary.

In the tradition of days past, if you have candles that you would like blessed, please bring them to weekend Masses on Saturday and Sunday, FEBRUARY 1st & 2ND (CANDLEMAS DAY). If you don't have any at home, candles can be purchase in the candle room.

FEAST OF ST. BLAISE MONDAY, FEBRUARY 3, 2025

St. Blaise, an early Christian <u>bishop</u> and <u>martyr</u>, is one of the most popular <u>medieval saints</u>. He is venerated as the <u>patron saint</u> of sufferers from <u>throat diseases</u> and of <u>wool</u> combers and as one of the Fourteen Holy Helpers.

The Outreach Line operates from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. daily. Monday through Friday. A trained mental health professional responds to the line. TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION The Presentation of the Lord (February 2)

By Candlemas, forty days after Christmas, February 2, the season of Christ's coming has depleted our candle supply. Soon, the parish will order a new paschal candle from a catalogue or candlemaker, or in some communities, wax will be collected to be melted and molded. Last year's paschal candle shows the wear and tear of summer heat, or many funerals or baptisms. Paschal candles have been around since at least the fourth century, when Constantine's biographer Eusebius reported that the night of the sacred vigil was "transformed into the brilliancy of day, by lighting throughout the city pillars of wax, while burning lamps in every place so that the splendor of this night was brighter than the brightest daylight." Light was a precious commodity in the ancient world, and this lavish use of precious beeswax was a sign of the Christian's call to bear Christ's light into the world's darkness. In a preelectric age, a whole city aglow from the paschal flame must have been a glorious sight, and a reminder to every baptized Christian of our vocation to "be the light of the world."
