

-Advocate Letter, by Tom Venzor, November 01, 2025

The Nebraska Catholic Conference has an important and exciting but bittersweet update as we kick off November!

One year ago at this time, we were frantically working together to defeat pro-abortion Initiative 439 and pass pro-life Initiative 434. Several weeks later, we were celebrating the defeat of the abortion industry and the protection of human life on Election Night and at our annual Bishops' Pro-Life Banquet & Conference. Sometimes, it feels like yesterday, and other times it feels like decades ago.

In the past year, God has continued to bless our work, including having the opportunity to think more deeply about our vision, mission, staff, resources, and events. In that discernment, it became clear to us that we need to shift time, energy, and resources to events that have the greatest impact on our pro-life public policy work (more on this below). This also means we have decided to no longer host the annual Bishops' Pro-Life Banquet & Conference.

United States Conference of Catholic Bishops

-Bishops respond to President Trump on IVF

President Trump announced new policies on October 16 to make *in vitro* fertilization (IVF) more affordable. Bishop chairmen of three relevant USCCB committees <u>responded the next day</u>, reemphasizing the harms of IVF while also expressing hope that ethical restorative reproductive medicine will be able to make strides within the newly announced plans as well.

-New IVF Podcast

-FDA Approves Chemical Abortion Drug

On October 2nd, the U.S. Food & Drug Administration (FDA) was reported to have approved a new generic drug for the abortion pill, mifepristone. Bishop Thomas, chairman of the USCCB's Committee on Pro-Life Activities, <u>responded in a statement</u>, calling the decision especially "jarring" because the FDA is meanwhile reviewing the dangers of mifepristone to mothers.

-Samaritanus bonus

In 2020, the Vatican released the letter *Samaritanus bonus*, "on the care of persons in the critical and terminal phases of life." The Secretariat of Pro-Life Activities' <u>compendium</u> and <u>study guide</u> introduce Catholics to this beautiful letter and help them reflect more deeply on its contents.

- Catholic Care for the Sick and Dying

A special edition "Word of Life" is <u>available in English and Spanish</u> that focuses on Catholic care for the sick and dying. This parish kit can be used at any point throughout the year, but is especially timely during November, a special time of remembrance and prayer for those who have gone before us.

Walking With Moms in Need

-Parishes Expand Services

<u>Several parishes</u> in the Diocese of Rochester have started Walking with Moms in Need ministries in response to <u>their bishop's request</u> to "renew and expand their services to women and children." Parishes are developing methods of accompaniment and support, from connecting moms with local pregnancy resource centers to incorporating spiritual works of mercy.
