2025 PRO-LIFE YOUTH ART CONTEST APPLICATION

<u>CONTEST DEADLINE</u>: Must be received in the Chancery Office by Feb. 21st by noon. No exceptions can be allowed due to time constraints to get first-place winners submitted to NE Knights of Columbus for the Statewide Contest

ELIGIBILITY: Any Student (Grades K-6) residing within the Diocese of Grand Island boundaries. Entrants can be from a public, parochial, home school, *or parish classroom*. (Special needs children, those on IEP, please write "special" for grade). Outside parties are brought in to judge, so all rules and instructions must be met for the entry to be eligible.

RULES:

- Design must be on an $8-1/2" \times 11"$ (letter size) paper with a minimum 1/2" clear border around the outside edge However, the image/design can be smaller than $8 \frac{1}{2} \times 11$ (the image does not need to fill the page).
- Picture/drawing must have a *Culture of Life message or theme*.
- Pencils, crayons, markers, paints, etc. can be used.
- Top 3 Entries from each class must be received in the Chancery Office by noon on February 21, 2025. Teachers submitting for their classroom should set an earlier deadline (allowing ample time for the top 3 entries to be chosen and submitted to the Diocese.) Teachers should keep copies of their top 3 entries and the originals of all other submittals until notified by the Diocese that a final decision has been made.
- Contest winners become eligible to compete at the Knights of Columbus statewide contest. Entries received become the property of the Knights of Columbus Culture of Life Foundation and will not be returned.
- NO INFORMATION SHOULD BE ON THE FRONT OF THE ENTRY. Each entry must have a completed Entrant
 Application Form (page 2) taped to the back of their entry. Please inform students before they begin, not to
 write anything on the front as this will disqualify their entry. We bring in outside parties to judge the
 contests.

DIOCESAN PRIZES:

\$40 First prize and award certificate for each grade level

\$30 Second prize and award certificate for each grade level

\$20 Third prize and award certificate for each grade level

The top Diocesan applicants will also be forwarded onto the Knights of Columbus Culture of Life Foundation for Nebraska's statewide contest.

Updates on winners and requests for group photo's will be sent via email.

STATEWIDE PRIZES:

Below is the entrant application form to be taped on the back of each entry. Entries without this information will be disqualified. Teachers should NOT submit more than 3 entries per grade per parish/school.

Winners will be notified by mail or contacted through their schools or parishes. Entries will NOT be returned unless prior arrangements are made. Teachers should print copies before sending them in. Please Do not attach personal photographs.
