FROM OUR PASTOR**Christmas Thanks**

As we end the liturgical season of Christmas, I want to take this time to say thank you to many who made our celebrations so beautiful. I am grateful to our Liturgy Committee for all their hard work. Members of the decorating team who put all the poinsettias and trees up added a special touch. Members of the music team who provided all the song and accompaniment at the many liturgies helped us raise our voices to God. And for each parishioner who worshipped God at our parish, it was important that we each brought our own "piece" to the Liturgy to round out our celebration. Thank you as well to everyone who dropped off all sorts of goodies to the Rectory over the past weeks. We are so grateful to be loved and appreciated. Know of our continued gratitude for all you do for our parish and school communities.

**The Epiphany of the Lord**

Today we observe the great feast of The Epiphany of the Lord. The word "epiphany" comes from Greek and means manifestation or appearance. The stewardship way of life is one in which we live in grateful response to God's countless manifestations in our lives. Our Gospel passage, from Matthew, has much to teach us about stewardship, through the actions of the magi.

As good stewards, the magi were watching for manifestations of God's presence in their lives. "We have seen the star at its rising," they say. Good stewards are keenly aware of the "star" of God's presence and His gifts in their lives. It is this awareness that fills them with gratitude and the desire to both worship God and share His gifts with others. The magi were so filled with awe upon encountering

the newborn Jesus, they prostrated themselves before him and "opened their treasures and offered him gifts." This is precisely why good stewards generously share their material gifts — as a loving act of worship to an extravagantly loving God. Let us rejoice in God's manifestations in our lives and be watchful for the new ways He is calling us to share ourselves and our gifts in gratitude to our King in the year ahead.

Eucharistic Adoration – Adorers Needed

Next weekend we will be having a sign-up drive to increase participation in Eucharistic Adoration at our parish. To keep Eucharistic Adoration going at our parish on Tuesdays through Wednesday mornings, we need additional parishioners to commit to spending an hour with Jesus. We are in particular need during the middle of the night hours. We can also use adorers at other hours too so there are many options. Please prayerfully consider if you can commit to praying for one hour at our church. If we cannot fill the hours, we will have to reduce the time we offer Eucharistic Adoration. During this Eucharistic Revival, this is the perfect time to re-dedicate our efforts as a parish to adore our Lord.

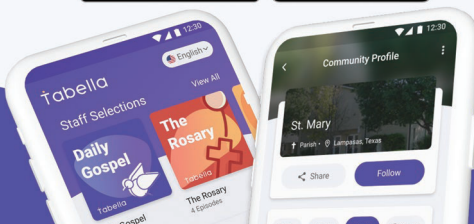

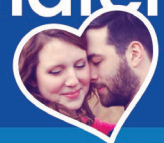
