The Epiphany of the Lord



Today we observe the great feast of The Epiphany of the Lord. The word "epiphany" comes from Greek and means manifestation or appearance. The stewardship way of life is one in which we live in grateful response to God's countless manifestations in our lives. Our Gospel passage, from Matthew, has much to teach us about stewardship, through the actions of the magi.

As good stewards, the magi were watching for manifestations of God's presence in their lives. "We have seen the star at its rising," they say. Good stewards are keenly aware of the "star" of God's presence and His gifts in their lives. It is this awareness that fills them with gratitude and the desire to both worship God and share His gifts with others. The magi were so filled with awe upon encountering

the newborn Jesus, they prostrated themselves before him and "opened their treasures and offered him gifts." This is precisely why good stewards generously share their material gifts — as a loving act of worship to an extravagantly loving God. Let us rejoice in God's manifestations in our lives and be watchful for the new ways He is calling us to share ourselves and our gifts in gratitude to our King in the year ahead.

Eucharistic Adoration - Adorers Needed

Next weekend we will be having a sign-up drive to increase participation in Eucharistic Adoration at our parish. To keep Eucharistic Adoration going at our parish on Tuesdays through Wednesday mornings, we need additional parishioners to commit to spending an hour with Jesus. Please prayerfully consider if you can commit to praying for one hour at our church. If we cannot fill the hours, we will have to reduce the time we offer Eucharistic Adoration. During this Eucharistic Revival, this is the perfect time to rededicate our efforts as a parish to adore our Lord.


