

FROM OUR PASTOR

All Things New Updates

St. Clare of Assisi

I want to thank everyone who took the opportunity to share your All Things New feedback over the past year. For my part, I have listened to many of your comments and desires for our parish and have met with our parish leaders. I have prayed about what I wanted to share, and I too have sent my thoughts to the Archdiocese. My comments came down to showing how I believe that St Clare of Assisi Parish and School should remain stand alone like many of our neighbors are proposed to do. I am confident that the feedback has been received and will be appropriately considered by the Archdiocese. As we move through the month of January, the Archdiocese will begin meeting to propose a final draft of models. Here is a timeline of where we are headed:

January 2023 - the Archdiocesan All Things New Team will use the survey inputs and comments from the Listening Sessions to revise the Draft Parish Models. Their goal will be to develop a single Draft Model for each Planning Area.

February 2023 – these Draft Models will be shown to the priests at a meeting scheduled on February 2. After that meeting, another round of Planning Area meetings will be held.

March 2023 - Draft Model Options revised with feedback from January through March.

May 2023 - Final decisions will be announced by Archbishop Rozanski on Pentecost Sunday, May 28.

Fall 2023 – Implementation will not begin until fall 2023 and will extend through 2026. Implementation will occur in a phased approach over time to allow for orderly planning and transition at the local level.

While we don't know what the future will hold, I trust that Jesus does know and He will allow what He wants to happen. We must continue to trust that God is in control of everything. Let us continue to fervently pray that God inspires Archbishop Rozanski to make good decisions. Please don't hesitate to reach out to me with questions.

The National Eucharistic Revival is the joyful, expectant, grassroots response of the entire Catholic Church in the U.S. to this divine invitation.




