OUR SCHOOL

- Founded in 1959, St. Rose of Lima School is a parish Catholic elementary school in the Diocese of Rockville Centre. The school educates students through 8th grade. Full-day Kindergarten is offered in addition to a Preschool Program for Nursery and PreKindergarten children. The Preschool Program implements the NYS Next Generation Standards.

ACCREDITATION

- St. Rose (Preschool and K-8) is accredited by Cognia.



REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION

- Nursery: Child must be age three by December 1st of the enrollment year
- PreKindergarten: Child must be age four by December 1st of the enrollment year
- Proof of immunization is required

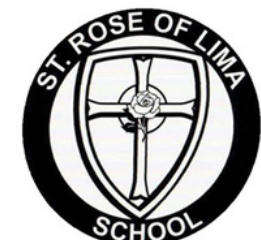
