During math, we will be finishing up with Area. There will be a math test on Thursday. We will finish up the month of January with a unit on graphing. The multiplication ice cream sundae challenge should be wrapping up just before February break. This week most of the class will be taking the test on the 9's. There are a few that are making up the 7's and 8's.

We have begun our unit on Early Exploration. I will be sending home the next report/project by the end of the week The seventh graders will be coming in this week to give presentations on various explorers. They are very excited for this opportunity and I think the third graders will enjoy hearing from them. In science we will continue with our unit on weather.


Catholic Schools Week is just around the corner. A schedule of events, activities, dress downs and lunches was sent home via
