

You proved that "A priest is not without his people." I am just in awe and overwhelmed by such love and support from you, my family, and friends. I thank all the priests, deacons, religious sisters, seminarian, and all the faithful who attended the Mass. I hold you all dear in my heart and will be praying for you all.

Who is My Neighbor? On this 15th Sunday in Ordinary time, the gospel reading tells the popular story of the Good Samaritan. The Samaritans were northern Jews who had intermarried with foreign settlers. They were despised by other Jews and were not allowed to help rebuild the temple in Jerusalem after the exile in about 520B.C. The Samaritans then built their own temple and had their own priests. That was the basis of the hostilities that grew between Jews and the Samaritans which was handed down from one generation to the other. At the time of Christ, Jerusalem to Jericho was a very dangerous road. It is about 20 miles apart but very steep as it dropped 3,600 feet. The road is narrow and steep and is used by bandits and thieves at night.

The traveler in the gospel story was most probably a Jewish merchant with goods and money (a good target for brigands). His decision to travel alone at night on such a dangerous road was certainly not a wise one. He fell into the hands of the robbers who beat him and left him half-dead. Two pious and devoted Jews, a priest and a Levite, passed by but they would not help the dying man. They were afraid of their safety and wanted to avoid being religiously unclean (Number 9:11). The Good Samaritan, on his part, noticed the anguish on the face of the dying man and took care of him. He took a risk in doing so but he helped even though it was inconvenient for him.

A neighbor is anyone in need. The Good Samaritan went beyond the racial hostilities that existed between him and the man. It is not always easy to get beyond our individual prejudices, but this is what the gospel is challenging us to do today. The traveler who was half-dead could not ask but he was helped by a man who knew he needed help. We are all on a journey here on earth. We are pilgrims along the way. We may be the one that need help, or we may be the one called to help another person. Let us not shy away from the good we can do for others.



Agradezco a Dios el don de mis padres, quienes pudieron celebrar conmigo, y la alegría de mi vocación. Que Dios recompense su generosidad y sacrificios. Cuenten con mis oraciones y misas diarias por sus intenciones. Que Dios bendiga a su iglesia con más sacerdotes y religiosos para servirle en su pueblo. ¡Amén!

¿Quién es mi prójimo? En este 15.º Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario, el Evangelio narra la popular historia del Buen Samaritano. Los samaritanos eran judíos del norte que se habían casado con colonos extranjeros. Fueron despreciados por otros judíos y no se les permitió ayudar a reconstruir el templo de Jerusalén después del exilio, alrededor del año 520 a. C. Los samaritanos construyeron entonces su propio templo y tuvieron sus propios sacerdotes. Esa fue la base de las hostilidades que surgieron entre judíos y samaritanos, y que se transmitieron de generación en generación. En tiempos de Cristo, el camino de Jerusalén a Jericó era muy peligroso. Estaba a unos 32 kilómetros de distancia, era muy elevado, con un desnivel de 1180 metros. El camino era estrecho, y fue utilizado por bandidos y ladrones durante la noche.

El viajero del relato evangélico probablemente era un comerciante judío con bienes y dinero (un blanco fácil para los bandidos). Su decisión de viajar solo de noche por un camino tan peligroso ciertamente no fue sabia. Cayó en manos de los ladrones, quienes lo golpearon y lo dejaron medio muerto. Dos judíos piadosos y devotos, un sacerdote y un levita, pasaron por allí, pero no quisieron ayudar al moribundo. Temían por su seguridad y querían evitar la impureza religiosa (Números 9:11). El Buen Samaritano, por su parte, notó la angustia en el rostro del moribundo y lo cuidó. Se arriesgó, pero lo ayudó aunque le resultara incómodo.

Un prójimo es cualquier persona necesitada. El Buen Samaritano fue más allá de las hostilidades raciales que existían entre él y el hombre. No siempre es fácil superar nuestros prejuicios individuales, pero esto es lo que el Evangelio nos reta a hacer hoy. El viajero medio muerto no podía pedir auxilio, pero recibió la ayuda de un hombre que sabía que lo necesitaba. Todos estamos en un viaje aquí en la tierra. Somos peregrinos en el camino. Puede que seamos nosotros quienes necesitemos ayuda, o puede que seamos nosotros quienes estemos llamados a ayudar a otra persona. No huyamos del bien que podamos hacer por los demás.


Thank You Youth!
