In our second reading today from the letter to the Hebrews faith is defined as "the realization of what is hoped for, and evidence of things not seen" (Heb. 11:1). In the translation of the Jerusalem Bible, the text reads: Only faith can guarantee the blessings that we hope for or prove the existence of realities that are unseen." The letter to the Hebrews gave examples of faith exhibited by Abraham, our father in faith. This we find also in the book of Genesis, chapters 12 - 25. God called Abraham to leave his country and go to a place he did not know. He trusted in the word of God and obeyed. When God told Abraham that he would become the father of nations, he did not doubt, even though the odds were against him. After his son Isaac was born, God again demanded that Abraham offer Isaac as a sacrifice. Abraham obeyed, knowing that God will always provide for him. All through his life, Abraham displayed a deep sense of faith in God.

It is becoming exceedingly difficult to talk about faith in a world that wants to verify everything with empirical data. Everyone wants to feel, touch, taste, see, and smell before believing what God is doing. Yes, God gave us the senses, but he has also given us faith to trust that what he has said will come to pass. St. Thomas Aquinas said it beautifully well in his famous Eucharistic hymn (Tantum Ergo) "Faith supplies for all defects where feeble senses fail." Our senses are meant to lead us to a point where faith takes over. That is what Abraham did. He developed a deep relationship with God, and nothing else matters to him except this relationship.

Jesus in the gospel says: "Where your treasure is, there will your heart be also." It seems to me that Abraham treasured his relationship with God and so would do everything to keep that treasure. In every situation in life, his heart was always with God, who helped him, provided for him, and saved him. The question then is: What do you and I treasure? What comes to your mind when you wake up in the morning? When something happens to you, whether joyful or sorrowful, where does your heart go? Our honest answer to these questions will help us know where we are in our Christian journey. Like Abraham, we must make our faith our greatest treasure. The servants who patiently waited for their master's return and opened the door when he came were rewarded. They had faith in their master and treasured their relationship with him. But the ones who decided to do whatever they liked were punished when the master returned, but found them unprepared for him. Our faith in God helps us to see him present in our world, and it challenges us daily to be watchful and faithful servants of his graces. He has given us many blessings, and he expects more from us.

Welcome to a new school year: We thank God for protecting and keeping safe our students, teachers, and parents during the summer. As you begin a new academic session, 2025/26, we pray that God will guide your steps and help you to excel. Be aware of God's love and his many gifts in your lives. We urge you to use the gifts well so you can grow more.

En nuestra segunda lectura de hoy de la carta a los Hebreos, la fe se define como «la certeza de lo que se espera, y la convicción de lo que no se ve» (Hebreos 11:1). En la traducción de la Biblia de Jerusalén, el texto dice: «Solo la fe puede garantizar las bendiciones que esperamos o comprobar la existencia de realidades invisibles». La carta a los Hebreos dio ejemplos de la fe demostrada por Abraham, nuestro padre en la fe. Esto también lo encontramos en el libro del Génesis, capítulos 12-25. Dios llamó a Abraham a dejar su tierra e ir a un lugar desconocido. Confío en la palabra de Dios y obedeció. Cuando Dios le dijo a Abraham que se convertiría en padre de naciones, no dudó, a pesar de las adversidades. Tras el nacimiento de su hijo Isaac, Dios volvió a exigirle que lo ofreciera como sacrificio. Abraham obedeció, sabiendo que Dios siempre proveería para él. A lo largo de su vida, Abraham demostró una profunda fe en Dios.


Se está volviendo extremadamente difícil hablar de fe en un mundo que quiere verificarlo todo con datos empíricos. Todos quieren sentir, tocar, gustar, ver y oler antes de creer en lo que Dios está haciendo. Si bien Dios nos ha dado los sentidos, también nos da la fe para confiar en que lo que ha dicho se cumplirá. Santo Tomás de Aquino lo expresó maravillosamente en su famoso himno eucarístico (Tantum Ergo). La fe añade lo que le falta al defecto de los sentido. Nuestros sentidos están destinados a guiarnos hasta el punto en que la fe se impone. Eso fue lo que hizo Abraham. Desarrolló una profunda relación con Dios, y nada más le importa excepto esta relación.

Jesús en el Evangelio dice: «Donde esté tu tesoro, allí estará también tu corazón». Me parece que Abraham atesoraba su relación con Dios y por eso hacía todo lo posible por conservar ese tesoro. En cada situación de la vida, su corazón estaba siempre con Dios, quien lo ayudaba, proveía para él y lo salvaba. La pregunta entonces es: ¿Qué atesoramos tú y yo? ¿Qué te viene a la mente cuando te despiertas por la mañana? Cuando te sucede algo, ya sea alegre o triste, ¿a dónde va tu corazón? Nuestra respuesta honesta a estas preguntas nos ayudará a saber dónde estamos en nuestro camino cristiano. Como Abraham, debemos hacer de nuestra fe nuestro mayor tesoro. Los sirvientes que esperaron pacientemente el regreso de su amo y abrieron la puerta cuando llegó fueron recompensados. Tenían fe en su amo y atesoraban su relación con él. Pero los que decidieron hacer lo que quisieron fueron castigados cuando el amo regresó, porque los encontró desprevenidos. Nuestra fe en Dios nos ayuda a ver lo presente en nuestro mundo y nos desafía diariamente a ser siervos vigilantes y fieles de sus gracias. Él nos ha dado muchas bendiciones y espera más de nosotros.

Bienvenidos a un nuevo año escolar: Damos gracias a Dios por proteger y mantener seguros a nuestros estudiantes, maestros y padres de familia durante el verano. Al comenzar el nuevo ciclo escolar 2025/26, oramos para que Dios guíe sus pasos y los ayude a sobresalir. Sean conscientes del amor de Dios y de los muchos dones en sus vidas. Los instamos a aprovecharlos al máximo para que puedan crecer más.
