PALM SUNDAY OF THE LORD'S PASSION

The most sacred mysteries of our salvation are put on display this week. Palm Sunday begins Holy Week, the week in which our Saviour's salvific mission in the world reached its fulfillment. It is the most important week of the year and of all times, historically. Because of its significance, the Church compels us to pay attention, as the Lord Himself said: "Do this in remembrance of me" (Luke 22:19). The Lord's mission is so all important that this week we are invited to make a hard 'stop,' to reflect, to appreciate, to appropriate, to renew, and to celebrate what Christ's coming, suffering, and dying meant, means, and is doing in your life.

To reflect on why He had to come in the first place. How poor, miserable, and doomed our lives were and would have been if there was no hope of redemption and an eternal future. To reflect on the truth that His coming restored the friendship humanity lost with God. To reflect on what it would have meant if that breach had not been restored, what depth of hopelessness and despair would have pervaded the world today.

To appreciate His coming, because with it, He took our pain, suffering, and wounds away. For by His stripes, we have been healed (Isaiah 53:5). Many of us can tell our testimonies today, and by so doing, enjoy hearing the testimonies of many others. The conclusion of one person's testimony marks the start of another's story.

To appropriate the abundance of graces He left on earth for our continuous growth and transformation. The words of the Gospels are living words. What He did yesterday, He does today and tomorrow. That you and I can become any of the characters whose lives He touched and changed in the Gospels. That what they received, I too, can, today, receive the same.

To renew what was once vibrant but now stale. What was once on fire but now dim. To renew our faith, our convictions, our hopes, our aspirations, and our strengths. The renewal of our baptismal promises at Easter Vigil is meant to do that in us.

To celebrate, because Christ won the victory over death, darkness, defeat, and the devil. He has now given us the key, sword, and roadmap for all other victories of life. It means that when we fight, He is the one fighting in us. When we pray, He is praying in and through us. For He said, "alone you can do nothing" (John 15:5).

So, as we reflect on the readings and the passion narrative, we believe with the Church that the mysteries we celebrate are not just historical. They are renewed every moment we celebrate them. They are reenacted at every Mass, and they continue to redeem what is still unredeemed in us, parts of us that are still weak, broken, and wounded. We can still bring them to the Lord who died and rose to save us, to continue His work in us.

DOMINGO DE RAMOS DE LA PASIÓN DEL SEÑOR

Los misterios más sagrados de nuestra salvación se ponen de manifiesto esta semana. El Domingo de Ramos da inicio a la Semana Santa, la semana en la que la misión salvadora de nuestro Salvador en el mundo alcanzó su plenitud. Es históricamente la semana más importante del año y de todos los tiempos. Debido a su importancia, la Iglesia nos llama a prestar atención, como el mismo Señor dijo: "Hagan esto en memoria mía" (Lucas 22,19). La misión del Señor es tan importante que esta semana nos invita a hacer una pausa firme: para reflexionar, apreciar, apropiarnos, renovar y celebrar lo que la venida, el sufrimiento y la muerte de Cristo significaron, significan y están haciendo en nuestras vidas.

Para **Reflexionar** sobre por qué tuvo que venir en primer lugar: cuán pobres, miserables y condenadas eran y habrían sido nuestras vidas si no hubiera esperanza de redención y de un futuro eterno. Reflexionar sobre la verdad de que su venida restauró la amistad que la humanidad había perdido con Dios. Reflexionar sobre lo que habría significado si esa ruptura no hubiera sido restaurada: qué profundidades de desesperanza y angustia habrían invadido el mundo de hoy.

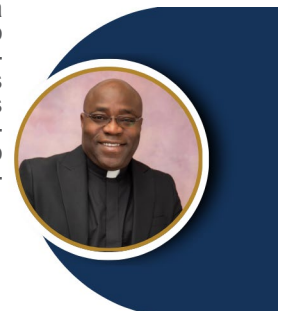
Para **Apreciar** su venida, porque con ella tomó nuestro dolor, sufrimiento y heridas. Por sus llagas hemos sido sanados (Isaías 53,5). Muchos de nosotros podemos compartir nuestros testimonios y, al hacerlo, ser fortalecidos por los testimonios de otros. El final del testimonio de una persona marca el comienzo de la historia de otra.

Para **Apropiarnos** de la abundancia de gracias que Él dejó en la tierra, para nuestro crecimiento y transformación continuos. Las palabras del Evangelio son palabras vivas. Lo que Él hizo ayer, lo hace hoy y mañana. Tú y yo podemos llegar a ser como aquellos personajes cuyas vidas Él tocó y transformó en los Evangelios, recibiendo hoy las mismas gracias que ellos recibieron.

Para **Renovar** lo que antes era vibrante y ahora está apagado; lo que antes ardía y ahora se ha debilitado. Renovar nuestra fe, nuestras convicciones, nuestras esperanzas, nuestras aspiraciones y nuestra fortaleza. La renovación de nuestras promesas bautismales en la Vigilia Pascual está destinada a obrar esto en nosotros.

Para **Celebrar**, porque Cristo ha vencido la muerte, la oscuridad, la derrota y al maligno. Ahora nos ha dado la clave, la espada y el camino para todas las demás victorias de la vida. Esto significa que cuando luchamos, es Él quien lucha en nosotros. Cuando oramos, es Él quien ora en nosotros y por medio de nosotros. Porque Él dijo: "sin mí no pueden hacer nada" (Juan 15,5).


Así, al reflexionar sobre las lecturas y el relato de la Pasión, creemos con la Iglesia que los misterios que celebramos no son solo históricos. Se renuevan cada vez que los celebramos. Se hacen presentes en cada Misa y continúan redimiendo lo que aún no ha sido redimido en nosotros: aquellas partes de nosotros que todavía están débiles, heridas y quebrantadas. Podemos llevarlas al Señor que murió y resucitó para salvarnos, permitiéndole continuar su obra en nosotros.
