In keeping with recent tradition in the Church, today is Divine Mercy Sunday. This feast is celebrated on the second Sunday of Easter. It was established for the universal Church by St. Pope John Paul II, on April 30, 2000, following the canonization of St. Faustina Kowalska. It is based on the private revelations received by St. Faustina from the Lord in the 1930s. The immense physical burden and fragile health under which these instructions and revelations came, would take every discerning mind's breath away. Between 1931 and 1938, St. Faustina reported in her diary (Divine Mercy In My Soul) that Jesus requested a feast to be held on the first Sunday after Easter.

Theologically, the feast is not merely based on St. Faustina's private revelations alone, but it fits the existing liturgical theme of the second Sunday of Easter Octave, which focuses on mercy and forgiveness. The readings heighten that theme effectively.

In the first reading, we encounter the early Christian community, formed by the impactful preaching of Peter on Pentecost Day. Having been moved by the revelation of God's mercy to all humanity, they came together to receive His love and fellowship. They formed themselves into a body of believers and devoted themselves to growing in the knowledge of God through the teaching of the apostles, the communal life, the breaking of the bread, and the prayers. The more our understanding of God's love grows, we appreciate His mercy even more. Today's Psalm taken from chapter 118 affirms that God's mercy endures forever. It enunciates the intimate dynamic of God's love manifesting through His mercy.

In the second reading, St. Peter celebrates the mercy of God which was made manifest in Christ and by it, we received a new hope and new life in Christ. This new life in Christ now affords us the inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept for us in heaven.

In the Gospel, Jesus categorically invests the Church with the power of God's mercy, through the sacrament of reconciliation. A sacrament of Divine Mercy: "Whose sins you forgive, they are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain, they are retained" (Jn 20:19-23). This means God has bound Himself to the Church to dispense His mercy at will. This is a floodgate of God's ocean of mercy to all of humanity. The Divine Mercy image revealed to St. Faustina says it all.

This outpouring occurred on the Cross of Calvary, and still does, as Jesus bled and hung dying on the Cross. His Precious and redeeming Blood still flows freely without hesitation, to wash away our personal, inherited, and original sins. Every soul is called to immerse, bathe, and be washed clean in His ocean of mercy. Approach the appropriate sacraments of mercy without hesitation.

This means, when a penitent approaches the sacrament of confession at the hands of a validly ordained priest and requests confession and receives absolution, their sins are forgiven forthwith. No questions. No doubts. What a gift. Honor it.

De acuerdo con la tradición reciente de la Iglesia, hoy celebramos el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia. Esta fiesta se celebra el segundo domingo de Pascua. Fue instituida para toda la Iglesia por San Juan Pablo II el 30 de abril del año 2000, después de la canonización de Santa Faustina Kowalska. Se basa en las revelaciones privadas que ella recibió del Señor en la década de 1930. A pesar de su frágil salud y las grandes dificultades que enfrentó, transmitió fielmente estos mensajes, que impresionan profundamente a quien los conoce. Entre 1931 y 1938, Santa Faustina escribió en su diario (La Divina Misericordia en mi alma) que Jesús pidió que se celebrara una fiesta el primer domingo después de Pascua.

Desde el punto de vista teológico, esta fiesta no se apoya únicamente en esas revelaciones privadas, sino que también encaja perfectamente con el sentido litúrgico del segundo domingo de la Octava de Pascua, que nos invita a reflexionar sobre la misericordia y el perdón. Las lecturas de hoy resaltan muy bien este mensaje.

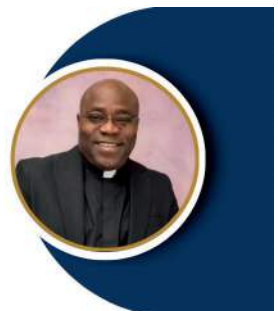
En la primera lectura encontramos a la primera comunidad cristiana, formada gracias a la predicación de Pedro el día de Pentecostés. Al descubrir la misericordia de Dios para toda la humanidad, se reunieron para vivir su amor y compartir como hermanos. Se organizaron como una comunidad de creyentes y se dedicaron a crecer en la fe a través de la enseñanza de los apóstoles, la vida en común, la fracción del pan y la oración. Cuanto más comprendemos el amor de Dios, más valoramos su misericordia. El salmo de hoy, tomado del capítulo 118, nos recuerda que la misericordia de Dios es eterna y que su amor se manifiesta precisamente a través de ella.

En la segunda lectura, San Pedro nos habla de la misericordia de Dios hecha realidad en Cristo. Gracias a ella, hemos recibido una nueva esperanza y una nueva vida. Esta vida nueva nos abre a una herencia que no se acaba, que es pura y que permanece para siempre, reservada para nosotros en el cielo.

En el Evangelio, Jesús le confía a la Iglesia el poder de transmitir la misericordia de Dios a través del sacramento de la reconciliación. Es el sacramento de la Divina Misericordia: "A quienes perdonen los pecados, les quedan perdonados; y a quienes se los retengan, les quedan retenidos" (Jn 20,19-23). Esto significa que Dios ha querido actuar a través de la Iglesia para ofrecernos su perdón. Es como una puerta abierta al inmenso océano de su misericordia para toda la humanidad. La imagen de la Divina Misericordia revelada a Santa Faustina lo expresa perfectamente.

Este amor y esta misericordia se derramaron en la Cruz del Calvario, y siguen presentes hoy. Jesús, al entregar su vida, derramó su Sangre preciosa y redentora, que continúa fluyendo para limpiar nuestros pecados: los personales, los heredados y el pecado original. Todos estamos llamados a acercarnos, a dejarnos envolver y a ser purificados en ese océano de misericordia. Acercuémonos sin miedo a los sacramentos, que son fuente de ese perdón.



Esto quiere decir que cuando una persona se acerca al sacramento de la confesión con un sacerdote válidamente ordenado, se confiesa y recibe la absolución, sus pecados quedan perdonados en ese mismo momento. Sin dudas, sin condiciones. ¡Qué regalo tan grande! Valóralo y aprovéchalo.

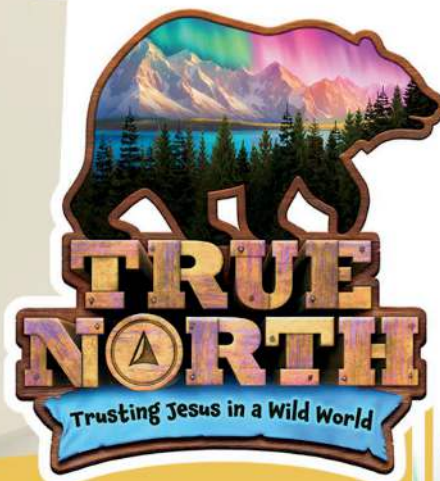

### April 14: Knights of Columbus Mexican Martyrs Relics Coming To St. Mary Magdalene

The Knights of Columbus Council 6878 are honored to host the venerated relics of the Mexican Martyrs on Tuesday, April 14, in the FLC.
