



From the Pastor's Desk

Dear Parishioners,

It gives me great joy to share with you the State of the Parish Report 2024. This report covers July 1, 2023, to June 30, 2024 fiscal year. It is an overview of who we are as a parish, the good works accomplished by parishioners, and the finances of the parish. We have statistics on the various aspects of our parish life including the sacraments, liturgical ministries, religious education, social services, parish ministries, and many more. I will highlight a few of these in this introduction.

We are a Eucharistic people; therefore, we give thanks to God for his goodness. For the first time in our parish history, we had two Eucharistic processions in one year! The long procession on the Feast of Christ the King (11/26/23), and a short one on the Feast of Corpus Christi (6/2/24). These processions attracted hundreds of parishioners who expressed their faith and belief in the true and real presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. Our adoration chapel had people visiting Monday to Friday from 9am to 9pm to spend an hour or more before Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. Parishioners spent over 15,000 hours for adoration during which prayers of thanksgiving, petition, and adoration were offered to the Lord who waits patiently to receive and attend to the needs of those who come.

As a family, we have been blessed by God who continues to grant increase and success to the work of our hands. Our parish continues to grow in number and strength. We enjoyed the support of parishioners who used their gifts, time, and treasure to support our parish thereby doing the work of evangelization. We are putting our faith into action as we assisted over 26,000 individuals during the year through our social service ministry. We visited the sick, we fed the hungry, we mourned with those who mourned, we rejoiced with those who rejoiced, and we were all things to all peoples so that God is praised in our community.

Thank you to all our parish staff, volunteers, and all parishioners who generously supported our parish in every way possible during the year. Together, we form the body of Christ, and we go out as disciples with the mission to serve others in our lives. I would like to thank specially the pastoral council, finance council, and the stewardship committee members for their leadership.

May the Peace of God, which passes all understanding, keep our hearts and minds in the knowledge and love of our Lord Jesus Christ (Philippians 4:7). God is good all the time, and all the time God is good!


