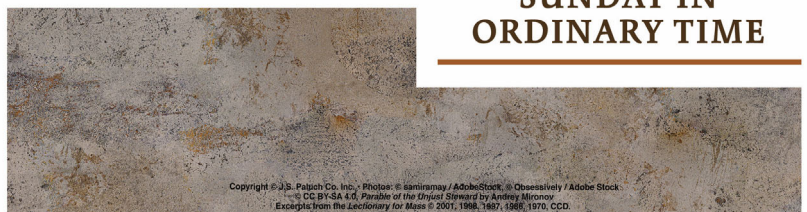

BAPTISMAL PREPARATION

Our Lady of the Rosary Baptismal Preparation consists of one mandatory Baptismal Seminar which consists of an information session which is on the first Saturday of the month at 9AM in the Parish Office. Call the parish office to register.

- Both parents and Godparents/sponsors are required to attend the Baptismal Seminar prior to the birth of the baby.
- Parents must provide a copy of the child's birth certificate.
- Godparents/Sponsors must meet Canon Law requirements:
 1. Be a Catholic.
 2. Be a practicing Catholic. This means, a Catholic person who is in an invalid marriage (not in a Catholic Church marriage) cannot be a sponsor/godparent. A cohabiting Catholic person who is not married, (living with someone) cannot be a godparent.
 3. Be sixteen (16) years of age or older.
 4. Must be a confirmed Catholic.
 5. A baptized non Catholic may stand as a witness, along with a confirmed Catholic.
