Instructions for Remote Learners

- On Tuesday morning, September 8th at 8:30, your child should be logged into Google Classroom
- Students should select the appropriate class and join the google meeting
- Your child will be provided any necessary codes to join additional subject meetings
- Students need a printer available to access materials given to students by their teacher
- Headphones should be available if working in a learning environment with other students or people
- All microphones are to be turned off unless teacher directs otherwise
- Student's device needs to be fully charged
- Device must have a camera
- Students are to be dressed in uniform and seated at a desk or table
- Students should have all materials needed for each class
- Attendance will be taken daily for each class and marked present, late, absent
- All students must show their face throughout the class session
- All assessments should be completed independently; device should be positioned so that the teacher can see the student
- All rules of the Student Handbook apply to behavior during testing session
- No cell phones are to be used
- All work needs to be submitted on time
- All lessons will be live not recorded
