

## ELA

#### Reading:

\*The program includes weekly spelling lessons, phonics, daily language practice, grammar instruction, and a written expression component.

Reading instruction is done with the whole class, and also in small groups. The students will take benchmark assessments to evaluate their progress.

The students will be able to:

\*Read with understanding.

\*Decode unfamiliar words.

\*Know long and short vowel sounds, consonant clusters and digraphs, and vowel combinations.

\*Recognize and use story vocabulary and high frequency words.

\*Identify story parts (beginning, middle, end)

\*Locate specific information in readings.





# ASSESSMENTS

- 3. <u>Math</u> Math tests will be given approximately once a month depending on the length and difficulty of the chapter. Students will receive a study guide to help prepare for the test.
