Summer Reading Assignment:

Over the summer, all students entering sixth grade **will be required to read one fiction or non-fiction book**. Also you need to read **2 Greek Myth Short Stories**. *You can probably find a book on Greek Mythology that has several stories in it and you can choose 2.*

You may select any age-appropriate book that interests you as long as you choose one from each of the following categories:

1. Two Greek Myth Short Stories (please **do not** read The Lightning Thief)
2. One Work of Fiction, Biography **or** Non-Fiction-your choice

For each of the three books/stories you read(a book and 2 myths), you will complete a worksheet for each. Print out the worksheet or type it on a google doc for each myth and book. A total of 3 worksheets. **Also please write down five new words learned with their definitions on the back.**

These reports are due by Friday of the first week of school and are to be handed in to their teacher. The reports will be graded and will count towards the first marking period grade for ELA.
