
We currently have two exciting teaching opportunities available:

The first position is for a part-time foreign language teacher, serving students in grades K-8 for approximately 26 hours per week, Monday through Friday. This role involves delivering engaging instruction aligned with the New York State Learning Standards for World Languages, with a focus on:

- Interpersonal Communication: Engaging students in spontaneous spoken or written exchanges in the target language.
- Interpretive Communication: Helping students understand spoken or written language presented in various formats.
- Presentational Communication: Guiding students to create spoken or written presentations for diverse audiences.
- Cultures: Encouraging students to explore and understand cultural practices, products, and perspectives of the language being studied.

The second position is a full-time middle school science teacher, responsible for Grade 7 General Science and Grade 8 Regents Biology. The role includes instruction in NYS-mandated laboratory investigations, preparing students for the Living Environment Regents Exam, and facilitating active scientific inquiry. This teacher will also lead 8th-grade health and religion instruction for the homeroom section, integrating a holistic, faith-based approach to student well-being and moral formation.
